Proceedings of 6th Meeting Of The Executive Committee Of State Authority Held On 22nd February, 2022 Under the Chairmanship of Sh. Ajay Shrivastva, IFS, PCCF (HoFF) HP -cum- Chairman, Executive Committee in the Conference Hall of Aranya Bhawan, Talland, Shimla.

At the outset, the Deputy Chief Executive Officer, HP State Authority welcomed the Chairperson and other members of the Executive Committee. Thereafter, the agenda items were discussed and deliberated upon at length.

The decisions taken on the agenda items of the meeting are as under:-

AGENDA ITEM - 6.1

Action Taken Report

Action Taken Report (ATR) on the decisions taken in the 5th meeting of the Executive Committee of H.P State Authority (CAMPA) was placed before the Executive Committee of State Authority for favour of perusal and approval.

Decision Taken: The Executive Committee perused the Action Taken Report and approved. Agenda stands dropped.

AGENDA ITEM - 6.2

Progress Report for the F.Y. 2020-21

The EC was apprised that during 2020-21, National Authority, CAMPA has approved the APO amounting to Rs. 158.395 erore and against which expenditure of Rs. 119.484 was incurred by HP State Authority. The detail of head/sector wise expenditure as per revised outlay was placed before the EC for favour of perusal and approval.

Decision taken: The Executive Committee perused the head/sector-wise detail of expenditure incurred during F.Y. 2020-21 and approved the same for placing it before Steering Committee of State Authority for perusal and approval.

AGENDA ITEM - 6.3

Progress of Expenditure for the year 2021-22

The EC was apprised that during 2021-22. National Authority has approved the APO amounting to Rs. 138.10 crore for the year 2021-22. The approval was received during August, 2021 and against which funds amounting to Rs. 40.60 crore have been spent upto 31.01.2022. The EC was also apprised that works are in progress in the field and the final position of expenditure shall be apprised in the next meeting after closing of the financial year.

Decision Taken: The Executive Committee perused the progress of expenditure upto 31.01.2022 and suggested to gear up the pace of expenditure. EC also suggested to request National Authority for conveying the approving the APO for next financial year on time so that the works in the field could be executed timely. It is also suggested by the EC that the APO from field offices will be prepare as per SoEs for works.

AGENDA ITEM - 6.4

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Approval of APO for 2022-23

The EC was apprised that APO for the year 2022-23 has been formulated keeping in view the provisions of CAF Act & Rules including permissible and prohibited activities. The committee was also informed in detail about the salient features and targets proposed in thrust areas in the APO for 2022-23. The sector wise detailed APO of Rs. 202.61 crore as per Annexure-II of the agenda was placed the Executive Committee for favour of perusal and approval before placing it before the Steering Committee for its consent for submitting to the National Authority.

Decision Taken: The Executive Committee, after detailed discussions and deliberations, approved the same for placing it before the Steering Committee for approval with following suggestions:

EC suggested to review the activities proposed in the APO for the year 2022-23 as the amount proposed is very high as compared to previous year APOs and also to keep in view slow pace of expenditure/progress

EC suggested to review the works done under Research training & capacity building in CAT Plan and also suggested to ask DFOs to send the consolidated information to the APCCF (R&T) S/nagar so that plan can be prepared for carrying out training and capacity building at their level.

EC suggested that the funds for lantana eradication should be distributed following micr watershed based approach.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the chair.
