- 2. Following new events will be introduced:
 - a. Squash, Men open and Men Vet.
 - b. 400 M walk, Women Sr. Vet.
 - c. 800 M walk, Men Sr. Vet., and women Veteran.
 - d. Badminton Women Vet.
- 3. There will be 6 teams for each game event viz: Kabaddi, Volley Ball and Basket Ball. The combination will be as under.
 - a. Team 1: Bilaspur and Hamirpur Circles.
 - b. Team 2: Mandi and Kullu Circles.
 - c. Team 3: Dharamshalla and Chamba Circles.
 - d. Team 4: Shimla and Nahan Circles.
 - e. Team 5: Direction office and Rampur Circle.
 - f. Team 6: HPFDC.
 - g. The WL and other functional circles players will participate from the respective (T) circles in which they are posted as per above combination.
 - h. The teams will be divided in two pools, Pool 'A' and Pool 'B'.
 - i. The teams of last year winner and runner will be put in different pools.

- a. There will be maximum two participants from each Forest Circle for each category.
- b. Only Winner and Runner up will be given the prize/medal.
- c. The winner's circle will get 3 points, runners circle 2 points and both semi-finalist circles will get 1 point each for the overall performance.
- d. While deciding the ties the last year's winners, runners and semi finalists will be put in the separate groups/pools.

4. Badminton + TT Doubles (Men Open/veteran/Sr. Veterans)

- a. There will be only one team from each Forest Circle for each category.
- b. Only Winner and Runner up will be given the prize/medal.
- c. The winner's circle will get 3 points, runners circle 2 points and both semi-finalist circles will get 1 point each for the overall performance.
- d. While deciding the ties the last year's winners, runners and semi finalists will be put in the separate groups/pools.

5. Badminton Doubles (Women Open)

- a. There will be only one team from each Forest Circle irrespective of the category.

- b. Only Winner and Runner up will be given the prize/medal.
- c. The winner's circle will get 3 points, runners circle 2 points and both semi-finalist circles will get 1 point each for the overall performance.
- d. While deciding the ties the last year's winners, runners and semi finalists will be put in the separate groups/pools.

7. Badminton Mixed Doubles

- a. There will be only one team from each Forest Circle irrespective of the category.
- b. Only Winner and Runner up will be given the prize/medal.
- c. The winner's circle will get 3 points, runners circle 2 points and both semi-finalist circles will get 1 point each for the overall performance.
- d. While deciding the ties the last year's winners, runners and semi finalists will be put in the separate groups/pools.
- 8. **For Carom singles and doubles:** The event will be only of open category and each circle can have two participants for singles and one team for doubles.

- 9. **Chess:** The event will be only of open category and each circle can have two participants.
- 10. Events will be played as per standard national/international rules.
