NOTIFICATION

Whereas "The COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATAION FUND ACT, 2016 (38 of 2016)", passed by the Parliament, has been published by the Government of India in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary on 3rd August 2016.

- 2. AND whereas the Central Government, vide notification No. S.O. 3967(E) dated 13th August 2018, has appointed the 30th day of September 2018 as the date on which the provisions of the said Act shall come into force.
- 3. AND whereas sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act 2016 (38 of 2016) provides that:-

"With effect from such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint in this behalf, there shall be constituted a State Authority to be called the 'State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority' in each State:"

- 4. AND whereas the Central Government, vide notification No. S.O. 4856(E) dated 14.09.2018, has appointed the 30th day of September 2018 as the date of constitution of the State Authority to be called "The Himachal Pradesh Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority".
- Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act 2016 (38 of 2016), the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to constitute "The Himachal Pradesh Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority" (hereinafter refer to as the 'State Authority') in the State of Himachal Pradesh, for the purposes of this Act, with effect from the date of its publication in the official gazette.
- 6. The State Authority constituted in the State shall be responsible for the management of the State Compensatory Afforestation Fund (SCAF) of Himachal Pradesh and its utilisation as per the provisions of the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Act, 2016 and the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Rules, 2018.

- 7. The State Authority shall consist of a Governing Body and shall be assisted by a Steering Committee and an Executive Committee.
- 8. The Governing Body of the State Authority shall consist of the following, namely:—

 - ii. Review the working of the State Authority from time to time.
- 10. The Governing Body of the State Authority shall meet at least once in six months.
- 11. The Governing Body of the State Authority shall, in performance of its functions and powers under the Act, be assisted by the Steering Committee and the Executive Committee.
- 12. The Governing Body of the State Authority may with the prior concurrence of the State Government create posts in the State Authority at the level of Assistant Conservator of Forests and other officials to assist the Steering Committee and Executive Committee in performance of its functions.

- i. Scrutinise and approve with such amendments as it may deem fit and proper, the annual plan of operations prepared by the Executive Committee of the State Authority and send the same to the Executive Committee of the National Authority for final approval;
- ii. Monitor the progress of utilisation of funds released from the State Fund;
- iii. Review reports on decision taken by the Executive Committee;
- Approve, subject to prior concurrence of the State Government, proposals formulated by the Executive Committee for creation of posts in the State Authority;
- v. Approve annual report of the State Authority and send the same to the State Government to lay it, each year, in each House of the State Legislature;
- vi. Ensure inter-departmental coordination.

15. The Steering Committee of the State Authority shall meet at least once in every three months.

- 18. The Executive Committee of the State Authority shall meet at least once in every three months.
- 19. The State Authority shall prepare its budget for the next financial year, showing the estimated receipts and expenditure of the State Authority and forward the same to the State Government and the Central Government in each financial year by 31st December.
- 20. The State Government shall appoint an officer not below the rank of a Chief Conservator of Forests as the Chief Executive Officer of the State Authority.
- 21. The State Authority may appoint the following officers for a period not exceeding five years, to assist the Steering Committee and Executive Committee in performance of its functions under the Act, namely:—
 - Joint Chief Executive Officer not below the rank of a Conservator of Forests;
 - Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary in the State Government;
 - iii. Deputy Chief Executive Officer not below the rank of a Deputy Conservator of Forests.
